Driver's Meeting at 9:30AM, first car out at 9:45. We should arrive at the park by 11:00


There is a \$7.00 entrance fee to the park per car - cash in the correct amount will be collected at the Driver's Meeting.

You may notice some dates prior to January. The monthly report I receive is from the last business day of the previous month. I also include new members from e-mails I receive from national up to the date I write the Willkommen.

If you know of anyone in the club not receiving the newsletter, ask them to check their profile settings in their National PCA account. If they need help, they can send me an e-mail. I'll assist them in getting the information corrected. Some people not getting the announcements and newsletter because they have opted out of regional emails, or they no longer use the email listed in their national account. I use the national database to send out notices for the club.

Here is how to access your profile:

Log into PCA.org, look under your Profile and check which email is listed. If it is no longer correct, change it and don't forget to save. If the e-mail is correct, then check your email options. I had two people last month that opted out of Regional Messages. If you opt out, you won't get our emails!

Here's how to check:

Log into PCA.org and select Manage My Communications. That will be under the yellow bar of "edit my profile," the third option. Once in there uncheck Regional Communications (PCA- SAR).

I would like to remind you, the only login on our website is the newsletter login which we mail out each month. There is NO members-only login for individuals. Your National PCA login will not work on the pcasar.org website.

Mark your calendars for Saturday morning, April 2, because it's time for our club's semi-annual Community Service event. For many years our club has been committed to the Adopt-A-Roadway program as a very effective means of demonstrating our continued support to our community. The Adopt-A-Roadway program is part of the nationwide effort of sponsorship designed to help beautify our roadways by facilitating trash removal and saving the taxpayers of Pima County approximately \$250 per mile cleaned which translates into thousands of dollars saved. Signage along our portion of Orange Grove Road clearly recognizes PCA SAR's sponsorship.

This is a fun and not too strenuous task that will take about two hours of your time and will make you feel good about your participation in helping clean up our community. We would certainly appreciate lots of volunteers for this civic-oriented event. I highly recommend the Adopt-A-Roadway program as a fine community service event, not too labor intensive, and another perfect opportunity to get together with friends and our special cars.

The temperature should be perfect for our outdoor activity. We will meet at 7:30 AM at Beyond Bread on the southeast corner of Ina Road and Oracle Road for coffee and pastries provided by the club before the cleanup. Arizona Department of Transportation requires that we wear hard-soled, closed-toe shoes (no sandals) and comfortable clothing. Gloves and hats are recommended. Now Available For Acquisition at Porsche Tucson

This 1966 Porsche 911 coupe was produced in May of 1966 and delivered from the factory in Irish Green (6606) paint with brown leatherette interior, including Pepita inserts. Power from the 2.0L flat-six engine is transmitted to the rear wheels via a five-speed transaxle.

Subsequent to acquiring it from the previous owner of thirty years, a full mechanical and cosmetic restoration was completed in 2021. Total work exceeding \$100k was performed on this SWB 911, which included: bare metal stripping and repair, factory code repaint, new upholstery, top-end engine rebuild, carburetors rebuilt, transmission inspected and tested, electrical system inspected and repaired, chrome re-plating, and more. A factory tool kit, a Porsche Certificate of Authenticity and a visual chronicle of the restoration are amenities presented.


