



Picacho Peak Drive and Hike



New Name, New Location, Same Great Event

Over the past 2 years, we've seen dramatic change in almost every aspect of life. Our passion for cars and all things Porsche has been no exception to this. Though we made the best of a difficult situation with monthly Zoom meetings and the occasional small, socially distanced event, it hasn't been the same. 2021 saw the cancellation of the long-held and anticipated Tubac Classic car show. For many years, this single event has been a great representation of just how strong and eclectic the southern Arizona car culture is. For 2022, the return of the 27th Annual Sahuarita Classics Car Show came with a new name and a new location. On January 29, 2022, the PCA-SAR set off with a caravan of freshly detailed Porsches ranging from a 356 to a rare and seldom seen 959. When we arrived at the Quail Creek Veterans Municipal Park, we were joined by hundreds of other



automotive enthusiasts with cars representing everything from one-off custom builds to a 1966 Porsche 911 that recently completed a frame off restoration.

The event was held on two conjoined soccer fields showcasing 18 different automotive classes. Although I am biased, it seemed the Porsche class was the most well-represented marquee with just shy of 20 cars. Our class featured nearly every generation of 911; a 356, 912,





multiple Caymans, Boxsters, a Panamera, Cayenne SUV and even Porsche's first super car, the 959. With such a rare and incredible car like a 959 in our midst, the running joke amongst participants was that the real competition was for second place. With that in mind, it came as a complete shock that my '98 Vesuvio Metallic 993 Carrera S was awarded "best of class."



Warm weather, great food, beautiful cars and great friends - I believe it was the perfect start to 2022 and hopefully a step towards the normalcy that we've all been yearning for. The return of the Sahuarita Classic Car Show at its new venue was a great success and I look forward to an even better showing next year.


PREP & PASTRY



A speed and experience level for everyone: There will be several different "run groups" which will be separated by experience/skill level: Novice, Intermediate, Experienced and Advanced. There is a run group for everyone- so don't hesitate to sign up if you have little to no experience on the track.

To ensure everyone registered has a good time at the track, the number of cars in each run group is limited. Sign up early to avoid being waitlisted!

PCA Instructor School training on Friday: If you are currently instructing for the PCA and are looking to get your PCA National Instructor's card, this training is for you.

HPDE on Saturday: The full course (Configuration 1) will be run on Saturday as a HPDE only. You'll get four 25minute sessions of track time.

HPDE on Sunday: The full course (Configuration 2 Counter-Clockwise) will be run on Sunday as a HPDE only. You'll get four 25-minute sessions of track time.

Instructors are free! If this will be your first time attending a track day with AZ PCA or if you have not yet been approved to drive solo, you will be provided an instructor to ride along with you as well as classroom instruction to make the most of your day. Even if it is not your first time or if you have never driven at Inde Motorsports Ranch before, AZ PCA can accommodate (and encourages) an instructor to hone your driving skills (lead/follow instruction is available). There is a \$10 rental fee for the bluetooth communicator that's necessary.

Wanna just hang out and lend a hand? We are always looking for folks to help us run these events. If you'd like to volunteer to help us, we'd love that! There is a registration option for volunteering and you can pick from several different roles of participation.



The train going up on Friday is pulled by a diesel electric engine but the train on the return Saturday hopefully will be pulled by a steam engine. Space is very limited, and Steam Saturday always has a big draw.

Space is very limited on the Luxury Dome Car and at the El Tovar Hotel, so if you are interested, do not delay is booking. Their cancellation policy is very good (a least 3 days prior to departure date) so don't worry if something happens and you must cancel. If El Tovar is not available, an alternate hotel would be Kachina Lodge.


