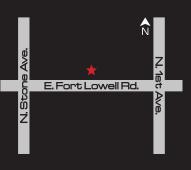





Porsche Parade and Treffen – Tips for Registering By Kathleen Kendler

There are two National PCA events that you should consider attending if you ever get the chance: Porsche Parade and Treffen. Both events are held at different locations each year. Parade happens once a year and is basically our National Convention – a week-long event featuring everything Porsche with as many as 1000 entrants. Activities include a concours, rally, competitive driving events, banquets, technical sessions, children's activities – the list goes on and on. Treffen is a more intimate event occurring twice a year with an emphasis on social events and driving tours. It is normally held at an upscale resort in the spring and fall.

Although Treffen in May is already sold out, there is still time to sign-up for the Poconos Porsche Parade in June and the Fall Treffen in Bend, Oregon. Registration for Treffen usually occurs three months before the event so the Fall Treffen registration should occur either late May or early June. The Porsche Parade for 2023 will be held in Palm Springs, CA, so not too far away! Here are a few tips to keep in mind if you want to attend either of these National events.

- 1. Know what tours/events you want to take before you start registration. You must sign up separately for yourself and your guest (usually your partner).
- 2. Have back-up events/tours selected in case they sell out. Trying to decide while signing up may only get you locked out of the event. Treffen usually fills within 15 minutes. Once all the slots are sold, you cannot go unless you are on the waitlist and are notified.
- 3. Know your sizes for included clothing items. If ordering extra or additional items know what you want and your sizes.
- 4. If you get the spiraling circle while signing in, it usually means the system is overwhelmed. If this happens, we try to re-sign into the site.
- 5. If you have food allergies state them or, if you are like me (I have many), state: "I'll e-mail the registrar my list."
- 6. The sooner you get to check out, the more likely you will get a slot.
- 7. Check your selected options before checking out completely. Sometimes, you're not on the same tour as the person you are traveling with. This is harder to change once you have registered completely.
- 8. If the person listed as your associate or co-member isn't going with you, change the status on your profile on the national site <u>before</u> you register for parade or Treffen. It'll save you time, trouble, aggravation, and money.

These tips are provided from my experience with the signup procedures and working the registration check-in table at Parade on numerous occasions. Hopefully, they will eliminate your frustration in the sign-up process. Also, provide constructive feedback to national if you have an issue.

Both Parade and Treffen are fantastic events that will leave any Porsche enthusiast with a wealth of memories. I encourage you to attend!


