



Wait! My Car Can Do What?!?! - PCA-SAR Car Control Clinic

PCA-SAR Driving Instructors put together a special event on December 11th. They offered a Car Control Clinic to help members learn to drive their cars in a safe, yet exciting, manner. Quite a few members took advantage of this great opportunity and spent the day learning all kinds of new things about their Porsches. I was excited to be one of them.

The day started with a series of exercises. For my group, our first experience was the slalom course. A group of cones were lined up and we had to snake our way through them, then follow along to a few corners of the Musselman track. Emphasis was not on speed, but rather on control and smoothness. As I got more comfortable with the course, my speed increased. Soon I was weaving my way through the course and feeling my Boxster get closer and closer to the "edge." It was a lot of fun.

Next up was the Skid Pad. This was a set of 2 circles, one large and one smaller. One at a time we started on the larger circle. We drove round and round the circle, setting the steering wheel at one spot and learning how to use the throttle to narrow or widen the radius of the turn. We then moved over to the smaller circle, necessitating more attention to keep the car in line with the cones. After a while, we made a figure 8, alternating between the larger and smaller circles and adapting to the different size radius. As in the Slalom exercise, the emphasis was on control and smoothness, but as my confidence increased, so did my speed. By the end of my sessions of going around and around and around, I felt more confident. But I also felt a little dizzy! Our last session was the Braking exercise. Heading down the main straight on the track, we gained speed and then hit the brakes as hard as we could. It was a chance to safely feel how the anti-lock system actually works. Hitting the brakes that hard caused a shudder in the brake pedal as the antilock system kicked in. It was good to experience that strange pedal feeling in the safe environment of the Car Control Clinic rather than out on the highway! We practiced that a few times, then moved on to trying to brake safely while heading into a turn, trying to avoid activating the anti-lock system.

Finally, it was time for a lunch break and a chance to socialize and compare experiences. After lunch, the full track was opened, and we had a chance to put our lessons to the test. We had many opportunities to make laps around the track and push our cars to the limits. As always, emphasis was on safety, but it was fun to see how my speed through the turns improved as the afternoon went on.

Many thanks go to Jim Kendler, and the rest of the PCA-SAR Driving Instructors, for putting on such an informative, yet fun, event. I know I learned an incredible amount about my car that day and I feel more confident driving it, knowing I can not only take full advantage of fun roads, but also do it safely. There has been discussion of making this an annual event and I hope it becomes one. The next time it is offered, I urge everyone to take advantage of the opportunity to really find out what your Porsche can do!


In Memoriam


