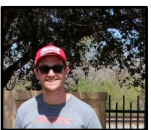

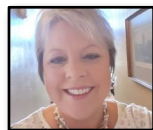

## SAR High Performance Driving Education (HPDE)

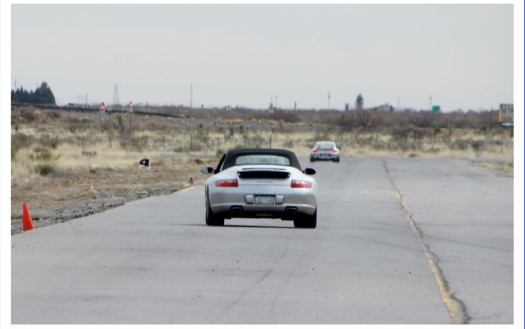
SAR hosted a HPDE at ASR the weekend of February 25<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup>. ASR is located at Exit 102/East I-10 in New Mexico. SAR has been using this track for many years. It is an ideal track for Novice (first time track drivers) and experienced drivers. First time HPDE participants will find the track relatively easy to learn and to practice the skills to legally explore their Porsche car limits. Experienced drivers were challenged with both clockwise and counterclockwise track configurations. SAR provided free instruction to all participants who requested an instructor. Both in-car and lead-follow instruction was provided Saturday and Sunday. Each participant had two + hours of track time on Saturday and 40 minutes on Sunday. Saturday's weather was excellent, but Sunday's winter storm shut the track down mid-morning. No-host group lunch was held Saturday and Sunday. The Saturday night group dinner at Si Senior for the participants was a great event to discuss track experiences and to ask questions to the instructors and experienced drivers.

# JOIN US AT ONE OF THE BEST TRACKS AROUND FOR A WEEKEND OF FUN! March 25-26



Please join the Arizona Region at Inde Motorsports Ranch for another amazing Driver's Education event of the 2022/2023 season. Inde Motorsports Ranch is located in Willcox, AZ, and is a 2.75 mile, 21 turn road course, featuring 200' of natural elevation changes and plenty of runoff space.

**A speed and experience level for everyone:** There will be several different "run groups" which will be separated by experience/skill level: Novice, Intermediate, Experienced and Advanced. There is a run group for everyone- so don't hesitate to sign up if you have little to no experience on track.

To ensure everyone registered has a good time at the track, the amount of cars in each run group is limited. **Sign up early to avoid being wait-listed!**

**Instructors are free!** If this will be your first time attending a track day with AZ PCA or if you have not yet been approved to drive solo, you will be provided an instructor to ride along with you as well as classroom instruction to make the most of your day. Even if it is not your first time or if you have never driven at Inde Motorsports Ranch before, AZ PCA can accommodate (and encourages) an instructor to hone your driving skills (lead/follow instruction is available). There is a \$10 rental fee for the bluetooth communicator that's necessary. If you need a helmet, please indicate so during the online registration process.

Don't forget to bring a chair, water and sunscreen and plan accordingly for the weather. All DE events run rain or shine.

**Wanna just hang out and lend a hand?** We are always looking for folks to help us run these events. If you'd like to volunteer to help us, we'd love that! There is a registration option for volunteering and you can pick from several different roles of participation.
