Rennsport Reunion 7

FACTS Reunion # 7 Sept. 28 to Oct. 2, 2023

- 22 hours driving trip from Tucson to Laguna Seca and return in our 2014 Boxster S. Average 33.9 MPG at 70MPH
- Fossil Fuel price in CA up to \$5.89 a gallon
- Fossil Fuel price in AZ, 10 miles from the border with CA, \$4.47 a gallon
- Observed Reunion from the Start/Finish Club above the track, Fri.-Sun.
- Over 850 Porsche owners with their cars
- Opportunity to drive my Boxster S on the Laguna Seca track – Parade Lap style (no engagements/no passing)
- Major redo (\$\$) of the track, facilities, and the Start/Finish bridge.

This was a Rennsport Reunion to top them all.

Since WeatherTech took over Laguna Seca Raceway, their investment in upgrading the facility is obvious from the start. Combine that with the 75th Anniversary of Porsche sports cars being celebrated, and you have an event where success is a given. With every activity sold out for the entire weekend, it was one for the record books.

Porsche went all out to make it memorable – starting with the new Mission X EV, (paint is Rocket Metallic) which changes color from its Brown metallic look to almost a dark green, olive-like hue, depending on the viewing angle. While only a concept car presently, if they don't produce it, I will be most surprised. However, Michael Mayer, the designer, said it would need more work on the aerodynamics before he would be satisfied.

I saved most of my drooling for the GT3 Cup Race, and a Porsche 718 Spyder RS in Dark Blue Metallic, (starting at \$160,000) with a 9000 rpm tach and 3.2 seconds to 60 mph. (0-60 times are always understated by Porsche.) I simply couldn't get over how much the Boxster has changed at the high end, and how prices have risen faster than a GT3RS. By the way, speaking of fast, the Mission X is assumed to be able to set a new record for street legal lap time at Nürburgring ... not bad for a car that was only an idea at this time last year.

The racing for this year's Rennsport gathering included both Bruce Canepa and Patrick Long winning their

qualification races as well as their trophy races that followed. To put it all in perspective, Porsche unveiled the Porsche Rennsport Reunion 7 Mirage Sport Tech Sneakers. With very limited availability (Porsche's words, not mine) they have a price to match. That's what happens when you give tennis shoes to the marketing department to describe.

The drive back to Tucson had a built-in detour, stopping in Paso Robles overnight. If you haven't done the wine trail there, put it high on your list for your next trip. The Piccolo Hotel downtown to Buono Tavola, an Italian restaurant on Spring Street – a 5-to-10-minute walk from the hotel, with exceptional food and drink, will complete your road trip.

ps. I couldn't close without mentioning what we saw on I-210 on the way back from Laguna Seca – a GT3RS towing a Pre-A 356 on a trailer – whatever it takes!

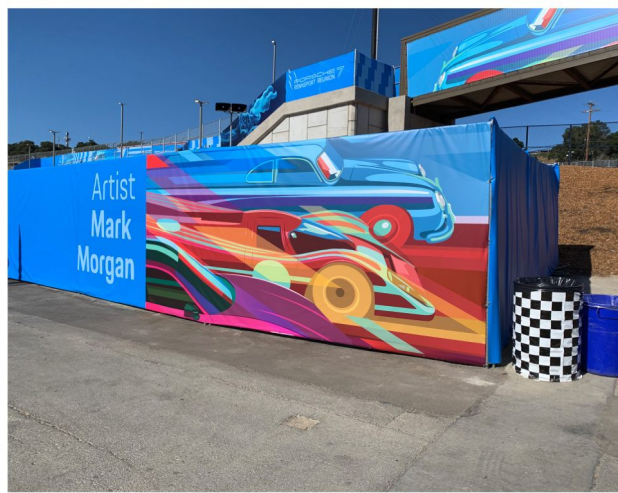

Car Control Clinic - Half-Day Autocross

Sunday, December 10th

This event is for new drivers or seasoned drivers, as well as those who want to improve their driving skills. The one-day event is spent learning, practicing, and experiencing car dynamics through a series of 3 key skills, all of which require you to learn to look ahead while driving.



This year, we are opening up the afternoon autocross to drivers who don't want to attend the morning clinic but want to enjoy some track time.

- 1) Smooth Steering on a Slalom Course - Understand how to navigate your car smoothly through a set of cones. Recognize where you want your car to go. You will learn how to drive where the cones aren't.
- 2) Threshold and Trail Braking - Learn how to control your car in an emergency situation. You will understand more about your car's capabilities and how to manage them. Learn how to successfully maneuver around obstacles (just as if you have a deer in the headlights) while slowing your car.
- 3) Skid-Pad Activities - Drive on a skid-pad where you will have the opportunity to experience your car breaking traction and then learn how to regain traction in a safe environment. Feel the balance and learn how to steer your car with the throttle.
- 4) Autocross - After the car control clinic we are offering the rest of the afternoon as a complete autocross so that you can practice and test your newly learned skills. The Autocross is also available to do as a separate half-day afternoon event if you do not care to participate in the morning Car Control Clinic.

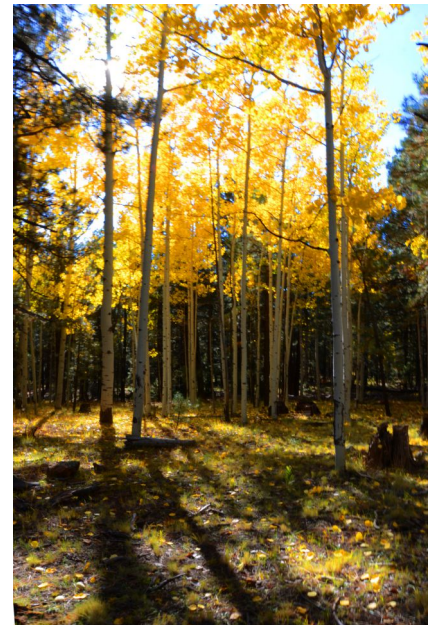
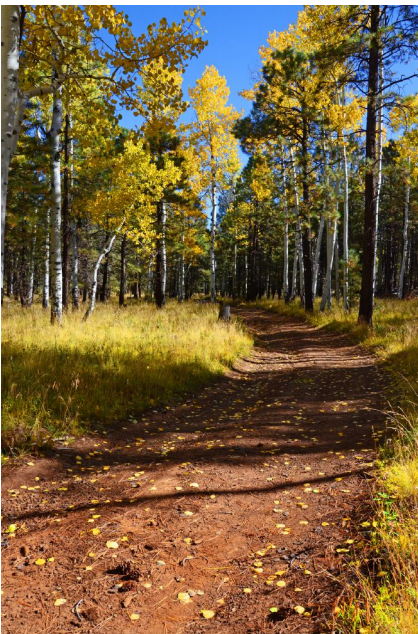


Speed Bump Continued.

The Arizona Snow Bowl turn off is on US 180, 15 miles north of Flag. Turn right and go 7 miles to the ski lodge and ski area at 9,500 feet. There is a good grove of aspen half-way up.

Several miles past the ski turn off is the entrance to Forest Road (FS) 151. It is called the Peak Loop that goes through Hart Prairie Meadow at 8,500 feet to wander back to US 180 41 miles later. It has marvelous views of golden patches of yellow on distant peaks as well as roadside groves of colorful aspens.

A shorter Forest Road but more interesting is FS 794 a few miles past the south entrance to FS 151. It winds up through groves of aspen to end in a large unnamed meadow surrounded by brilliant yellow aspen against a stormy sky.
