Hope you were able to enjoy some of the events available to SAR members in November. In addition to our monthly member dinner social meeting and our monthly Saturday morning breakfast, we had a car show at the Arizona State Veterans Home in Tucson, a yummy cinnamon roll tour and an overnight deep-space satellite array tour. Next up is our annual Holiday Party at Hacienda del Sol on the evening of Saturday, December 6<sup>th</sup>. I saw a number of you at these November events and hope to see everyone at the Holiday Party.

A somewhat unusual event available to SAR members that I attended in November was the lengthily-named Ultimate Porsche Showcase at the Bentley Scottsdale Polo Championships, held in Scottsdale on November 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>. Arizona Region put on the Porsche Showcase car show (about 20 Porsches) and in exchange, car show entrants were able to sit inside the huge Maserati tent alongside the polo field. The polo field is a huge grass expanse approximately 300 yards long by 160 yards wide. Each polo player needs to have four horses to ride, one for each 7-minute-long period. In between matches there was a Rugby exhibition. You think football can be rough, well, none of these players had any padding! Yes, my car is included in the “white collection” of Porsches in front of the Maserati tent. # Calling All Ladies to the Track!

Calling all ladies to the track.....

Recently I had the fabulous experience of being one of only two drivers driving solo on the track at Arroyo Seco in Deming, NM – and both of us were women! Talk about a lot of fun, but how did that happen?

I bought my first Porsche two years ago after wanting a Porsche for many years. The Porsche Club members (especially John Duclos) helped me learn what to look for and what to avoid in buying my first Porsche. The information he gave me was invaluable and it gave me the confidence to buy my 2019 Cayman S. I was looking forward to driving my car like it was designed to be driven, and what better place than a track? But first I needed to spend time with a few of the wonderful SAR region instructors.

My first event was a car control clinic at the Musseman track in Tucson. It's a small track, used for go-carts as well as cars. It was a great first experience. Part of the day was spent learning the basics of controlling your car. We drove around a series of cones that were placed in a straight line to get a feel for how the car handles and then drove around a circle of cones to understand how the car



behaves with different levels of acceleration (basically "steering with your feet"). The second half of the day was spent driving the track with an instructor in my car who pointed out basic driving tips like hand placement, seat placement, when to turn into the corners, and when to accelerate and brake. What a fun day it was! I remember how patient the instructors were, and how they made you feel safe and comfortable, and they always offered feedback and encouragement.

My next event was an actual High-Performance Driver Education event, also known as a track day. Sign up is based on skill level (novice for me). Sign up was easy, just click on the link in the PCA email that lists the upcoming track days. All novice drivers were placed in a group and the day was spent alternating between classroom (4) 20 minute sessions, and driving the track - also (4) 20 minute sessions. Instructors are assigned to all novice drivers and they are with you at all times when driving the track. Sometimes, for the first couple of laps, they may drive your car so that you can learn the layout of the track. It's a great way to eliminate any intimidation you may have about driving on an unfamiliar track.




The other run groups (intermediate and advanced) were on the track during their 20 minute sessions while I was in the classroom, or, spending time with my instructor learning all that I could. Since everyone in the novice group is new to track days the pace is appropriate and safety is always emphasized. There are strict rules for passing, and only in certain areas of the track. I have to give a shout out to Kai Gerkey, my wonderful instructor for INDE Motorsports Ranch in Willcox, and Podium Club in Casa Grande. He was unbelievably patient with me, answered a ton of questions, spent a lot of time walking me through a map of the track and encouraged me to continue learning with future track days.

Now back to Arroyo Seco in February... both Debi Norris and I were signed up in the novice group, but after several sessions our instructors gave us the go ahead to drive solo. Wow, was that a lot of fun.



It was unbelievably gratifying to know that I had advanced to the point of being able to drive on a track by myself. That was definitely a bucket list item. I can't believe how much I've learned, how much fun it has been, and how many friends I have made. I also can't believe I waited so long to do this. So ladies, do NOT be intimidated by going to the track. You will learn wonderful driving skills, meet new people, and, you will be able to tell your family and friends that you track your Porsche! How cool is that?

# Cinnamon Roll Tour




