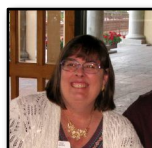

# Tour to Porsche Arrowhead

On April 3<sup>rd</sup>, a group of us drove up to Arrowhead Porsche in Glendale, AZ. It is the newest Porsche dealership to open in Arizona. It opened in September 2025 with a Grand Opening in December 2025. It is a Generation 5 facility with a 60,000 square foot showroom and state-of-the-art service area. It has two large viewing windows into the service area. One is on the bottom floor near the merchandise/waiting area. Upstairs has a conference table, a comfortable seating area, a car elevator (which is used to place some of the prized cars of Richard Cvijanovich, the owner, on display) and, a Porsche wall of model cars from past to present – my favorite.

The dealership is truly a “Destination Dealership.” The building conforms to the easily identifiable Porsche brand features of high ceilings with a louvered look from the outside entrance. It is also a 5-star service and sales facility. It has 21 bays, EV bays, Video car check in, and Porsche certified technicians ranging from Bronze, Silver, and Gold. Top tier service is provided by Porsche Academy and theirs is located the Dallas-Ft. Worth area. They offer service Monday through Saturday.

Several individuals took them up on their offer for the video car check-in. You drive through one of two check-in bays with digital and laser sensors that photograph your car in almost 360 degrees. You can see any dings or other mishaps you may not have noticed (which I find hard to believe any of you don’t know your car thoroughly). Pictured is

the scan of the tires on Jim’s car. As you can see, Jim changed his tires after the INDE track event. The technology easily identified that we have a camber issue. This reinforced Jim’s assessment at the track that the previous owner aggressively set the camber of the wheels for the track. We will now adjust the camber for better wear on the streets.

The dealership is magnificent, the service bays are cleaned nightly, and the staff is over-the-top in professionalism. They go out of their way to make you feel welcome. Mr. Cvijanovich took time out of his busy schedule to have lunch with us and discuss his philosophy on car dealerships. He owns quite a few in the Phoenix area, including the recently renovated Porsche of Chandler.

I don’t think any of us from Southern Arizona were disappointed in our tour of the facility. Smiles could be seen from ear to ear on all participants.

Thank you Arrowhead Porsche, Rich Cvijanovich, Mark Mauer (General Manager), and the staff for allowing us to tour their work area. I enjoyed the service bay area, talking with the technicians, and seeing an EV taken apart to perform the necessary service on the battery area. You all were outstanding.

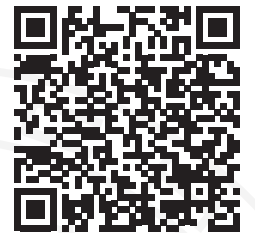

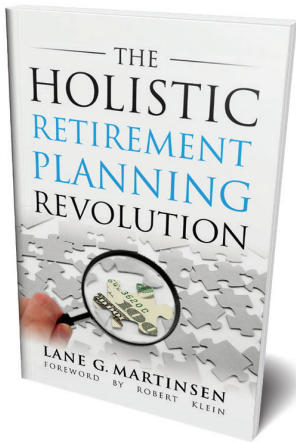
